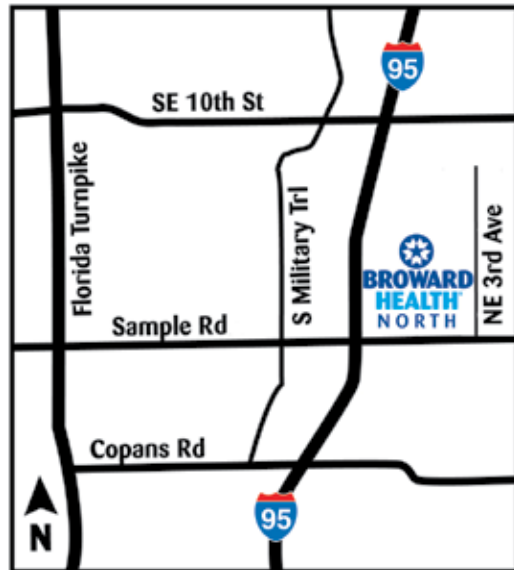

# COMMUNITY

## Grants and Community Support

Broward Health was awarded a total of \$9,545,928 in grant funds in fiscal year 2013; a 20 percent increase from the previous fiscal year. New funding brought in totaled \$3,252,417, a 173 percent increase over the previous year.

Some highlights include:

- More than \$3 million for Ryan White programming
- \$22,500 from the Susan G. Komen for the Cure Foundation to fund Genetic Testing for the BRAC 1 and 2 genes for uninsured patients
- \$2,500 from the Coventry Foundation to fund crisis assistance for families at Children's Diagnostic & Treatment Center
- \$13,850 in toys, a Wii Fun Center, teen kits for new cancer patients, and wagons for children at Chris Evert Children's Hospital
- \$866,642 to fund two new Community Health Services primary care centers in central Broward County
- \$1,000,000 to fund high impact prevention, outreach, and education to identify those living with HIV/AIDS and link them to care
- Launched Broward Health Fields Fit Fest events with pro football punter Brandon Fields and his wife Katie. The community outreach program served more than 400 children in 2013.



# BROWARD HEALTH FOUNDATION



In February, the Broward Health Foundation's Young President's Council held its inaugural Barefoot on the Beach event raising more than \$65,000 for Chris Evert Children's Hospital.

More than 125 people took off their shoes and danced in the sand on the private beach at the Harbor Beach Marriott Resort & Spa in Fort Lauderdale.

Later that month, American Heritage School's pre-med society held the 9th Annual 5K for a Better Day on the campus of Broward Health Medical Center. The race brought together more than 350 runners who helped raise nearly \$20,000 to benefit pediatric cancer patients at Chris Evert Children's Hospital.



In March, the Broward Health Coral Springs Lisa Boccard Fund partnered with the City of Coral Springs' Half Marathon and 5K for Women's Wellness. The race had more than 1,500 participants and raised almost \$25,000 to help women in the community battling breast cancer.



In April, more than \$550,000 was raised at The Salah Foundation Broward Health Ball. The event, presented by Turner Construction Company, drew more than 500 people for an evening of dinner, dancing, silent and live auctions. Proceeds funded programs at all Broward Health hospitals.

The Foundation also received a number of donations from generous community donors, including Suze Orman, who donated funds to purchase a new hana® Table for hip replacement surgeries. The Lillian S. Wells Foundation funded new ultrasound and stenograph equipment for the Lillian S. Wells Women's Health Center at Broward Health Medical Center, and A.J. Acker and Lorraine Thomas both made significant gifts toward the A.J. Acker Virtual Hospital at Broward Health North.
